

(Event 2) Leadership of People

Aim:

The overall aim of this workshop is to develop an understanding of how teams function and the role that a Leader plays in the team process. It will enable delegates to have an overall understanding of Leader and Team theory and apply it in practice:

This workshop will:

- Assist delegates to apply leadership learning and theory in a practical sense using an experiential approach
- Allow delegates to identify an action plan for utilising all new skills in improving self and team performance

Learning Objectives:

As a result of their learning delegates will be able to:

- Understand team role theory and know their own strengths and limitations within it
- Critically evaluate their own leadership performance against known models and theories
- Carry out structured and effective team briefings
- Plan, evaluate and critically review team performance as the leader of a team
- Understand and recognise a range of leadership styles and traits – know what a leader does
- Manage their time effectively across a range of tasks of differing durations and complexities

Having raised their own level of Personal Awareness, established their values and beliefs as a leader and looked at the generic leadership of teams, delegates will now consolidate all this learning and focus on the specific development of their team and its culture.
